

Greetings SHS Alumni!



Teachers Seek Improvements



Rashawn passed away last semester from injuries sustained during a tragic automobile accident. Rashawn will be remembered by his friends, family, and the SHS community for the legacy he left behind. Friends recall his smile, his laugh, and his personality as hallmarks of his character.

Friends and family remember Rashawn for his grit, perseverance, and integrity. While he faced some personal struggles of his own, he never let them get him down and obstacles weren’t a deterrent to him. Rather, he viewed them as challenges to be conquered.

Rashawn was a member of the SHS football and basketball teams. In fact, Rashawn was named to the 6A IFCA All-State team on December 1st, the very day of his accident. Though he excelled in football, his family knows he was more than a football player, he was a fine young man.

Head football coach, Brandon Winters reflected, “What I think everybody admired about Rashawn was he always had a smile on his face regardless of the situation.”




Alumni Bulletin
