




A Message from Our President, Brent Bockelman

This issue's featured Cardinal is Casey Smith ('14). After graduation, Casey studied journalism at Ball State University. She continued her studies at UC Berkeley where she focused on narrative science and investigative reporting. Throughout her college and post-college careers, Casey has been deeply involved in journalism. From serving as a college correspondent for *USA Today* to interning as an editorial intern at *National Geographic*, Casey has proven herself a journalist of high regard.

Casey has worked with the *Indy Star* where she covered stories across Indianapolis and the Hoosier State as a Pulliam Fellow. She is currently a member of the 2020 Report for America corps where she has covered the Indiana Statehouse for The Associated Press. Report for America is a national service program that places journalists into local newsrooms to report on under-covered issues and communities. An initiative of the nonprofit media organization, The GroundTruth Project, it is structured to harness the skills and idealism of an emerging group of journalists plus the creative spirit of local news organizations.

Currently, Casey is a Statehouse reporter for the Associated Press where she serves as a watchdog reporter covering elections, with focuses on the state attorney general's race and on U.S. House District 5. During the legislative session, Casey's reporting centers around K-12 funding and the effects of state policies on local districts. Casey also plans to give back to her Southport community. She will be running investigative reporting workshops with students of the current SHS *Journal* staff.
